As Manager of Supply Chain Management for Savannah River Remediation (SRR), Ellen Hansmann is responsible for carrying out the strategic procurement, warehousing, and logistics of an estimated \$1.2 billion of materials and services required for the liquid waste execution. Additionally, she is responsible for the supply chain management policies and procedures required for the Contractor Purchasing System certification received from the Department of Energy (DOE), as well as managing the SRR Small Business Subcontracting Program.

Ms. Hansmann has more than 18 years of experience in strategic sourcing, purchasing, and contract management, including five years of Government Contracting/Purchasing, six years in distribution, and three years in a manufacturing environment. In her previous positions as Purchasing and Logistics Manager at F&M Mafco, Ms. Hansmann managed inventory valued at over \$7 million across several North American branches, and managed an annual spend of \$49 million over several product categories that included safety, welding, and industrial gas products. As Purchasing Manager at the Habegger Corporation, Ms. Hansmann managed HVAC inventory and supplies across 28 branches nationally, valued at over \$9 million, and managed \$50 million in annual purchases.

Ms. Hansmann's position as Director of Materials Purchasing and Vendor Management at Fidelity Investments included the management of materials, transportation, and outsourcing subcontracts. She also served as a Contracts Manager for Fluor Fernald, Inc., at the former DOE Fernald Superfund Site located in Ohio, and was responsible for the negotiation and management of decontamination and demolition contracts.

Ms. Hansmann is a member of the Institute for Supply Management and is pursuing her Certified Professional in Supply Management (CPSM) accreditation.
