

Students, Teachers Achieving Results (STAR) Grant Information

The “Students, Teachers Achieving Results” (STAR) Grants are designed to recognize and support excellence in teaching by providing grant awards of up to \$1,000 to enhance elementary school science and mathematics programs. These grants are being offered for schools to purchase STEM-related (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math) kits, refurbishment of kits already used by schools, or to purchase new kits or tools to support your teaching in STEM areas.

Eligibility

- Elementary Schools in the South Carolina counties of Aiken, Allendale, Bamberg, Barnwell, Edgefield, and Orangeburg; and in the Georgia counties of Columbia and Richmond

Grant Categories

- Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics

Application Process

- Grant proposal packages are emailed to each elementary school principal.
- Applications can be completed by one elementary grade-level teacher or a group of elementary grade-level teachers. However, only ONE application per school will be accepted.
- Proposal must be submitted on the enclosed application, typed or neatly printed, and all requested information completed in the space provided.
- Proposals can be submitted for grants in any amount up to \$1,000.
- Proposals must be approved by the school principal.

Evaluation Criteria

- Project Summary: Provide a brief statement of the intended use of the grant funds.
- Goals/Objectives: List the top three learning objectives / curriculum concepts, which will be enhanced by this grant.
- Briefly explain why your school is deserving of this grant.

Schedule

- Application **MUST** be received by SRR by close of business on **February 1, 2018**.
- Copies should be sent by email to Madeline.Blair@srs.gov. A return email will be sent within 48 business hours of application receipt. In the subject line, type “SRR STAR Grant.” No paper copies will be accepted.
- Winners and non-winners will be notified before February 20, 2018.
